5. FORT ORD TRANSIT CORRIDOR PLAN LINE

The Committee received report on the transit corridor plan line through the former Fort Ord on Intergarrison Road and requested periodic updates on the transit corridor plan line through the former Fort Ord.

Jeff Morgan reported that in order to secure enough right of way for the future transit corridor through the former Fort Ord, the Fort Ord Reuse Authority, the County of Monterey Redevelopment Agency, California State University at Monterey Bay and the City of Marina are collaborating on the future plan line for the route. The plan includes 8-foot shoulders for bicycle traffic throughout the corridor and a separated 12-foot bicycle and pedestrian path along the north side of the road.

Robin Harness announced the Tour of California kick-off events would be held on February 21, 2007, in the City of Seaside.
