WEDNESDAY, MAY 19 -- TEMPORARY CARMEL VALLEY ROAD CLOSURE for CONSTRUCTION OF NEW BIKE AND WALKING TRAIL

Construction of the lighted pedestrian/bicycle underpass beneath Carmel Valley Road near the Highway 1 intersection will shift to the south side of Carmel Valley Road Wednesday evening. Full closure of Carmel Valley Road between Hwy 1 and Carmel Rancho Blvd will be required between 10 PM Wednesday and 5 AM Thursday morning. Traffic will be detoured around the location using Rio Road and Carmel Rancho Blvd.

Wednesday's schedule is:

10PM

- Full closure of Carmel Valley Road between Hwy 1 & Carmel Rancho Blvd – The existing temporary re-configure for 1 lane in each direction will be shifted from the north side to the south side of Carmel Valley Road.
- Hwy 1 –south-bound left turn lanes – will be closed for the evening.

5AM

- Re-open Carmel Valley Road in the current temporary 2-lane configuration.
- Re-open Hwy 1 left turn lane in the current temporary configuration.

After reopening Carmel Valley Road at approximately 5:00 AM Thursday morning, traffic controls and lane configurations will be the same as the current temporary construction conditions.
