FEDERAL STIMULUS PROJECTS IN MONTEREY COUNTY

May 1, 2009

At the April 29, 2009 Board of Directors meeting, the Transportation Agency for Monterey County approved programming Monterey County's remaining American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funds to the following projects:

1. \$10,450,000 of regional American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funds to the US 101/San Juan Road Interchange,
2. \$382,000 Transportation Enhancement designated American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funds to County of Monterey's Carmel Valley Greens Bicycle Path,
3. \$178,000 Transportation Enhancement designated American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funds to City of Salinas' Harvey Baker House Improvements project,
4. \$375,000 to City of Monterey's Del Monte Crash Reduction Signal Improvements, and
5. \$63,458 for non-urban transit service.

The final total of Monterey County's share of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funding for roadway infrastructure is \$19,689,000. At its February 25th meeting, the Transportation Agency for Monterey County Board of Directors approved a list of local projects totaling \$8,304,000. The remainder of the funds was programmed on April 29th. A summary of all transportation funding received in Monterey County from American Recovery and Reinvestment Act is attached. Twenty-three projects valued at over \$40 million have received funding.
