


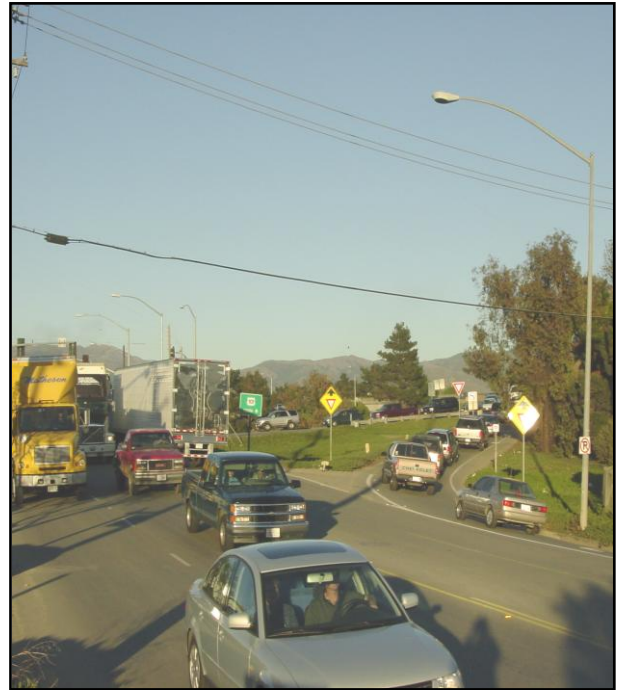
# Airport Blvd. Interchange East @ US 101

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

 The Airport Boulevard project has both regional and national significance. From March through November, 2,700 interstate trucks leave the Airport Blvd Interchange area of South Salinas each day transporting fresh vegetables to the rest of the nation. The project will widen the existing bridge over US 101, construct new northbound ramps, and make improvements to Airport Blvd and De la Torre. This project will address almost 75% of the congestion in the area over the next 10-15 years.

## PROJECT BENEFITS

- ▶ Improves safety for cars and trucks
- ▶ Facilitates movement of 2,700 trucks per day (peak season)
- ▶ Supports \$3 billion a year agricultural industry
- ▶ Provides traffic congestion relief
- ▶ Improves access to the industrial park and Salinas Municipal Airport

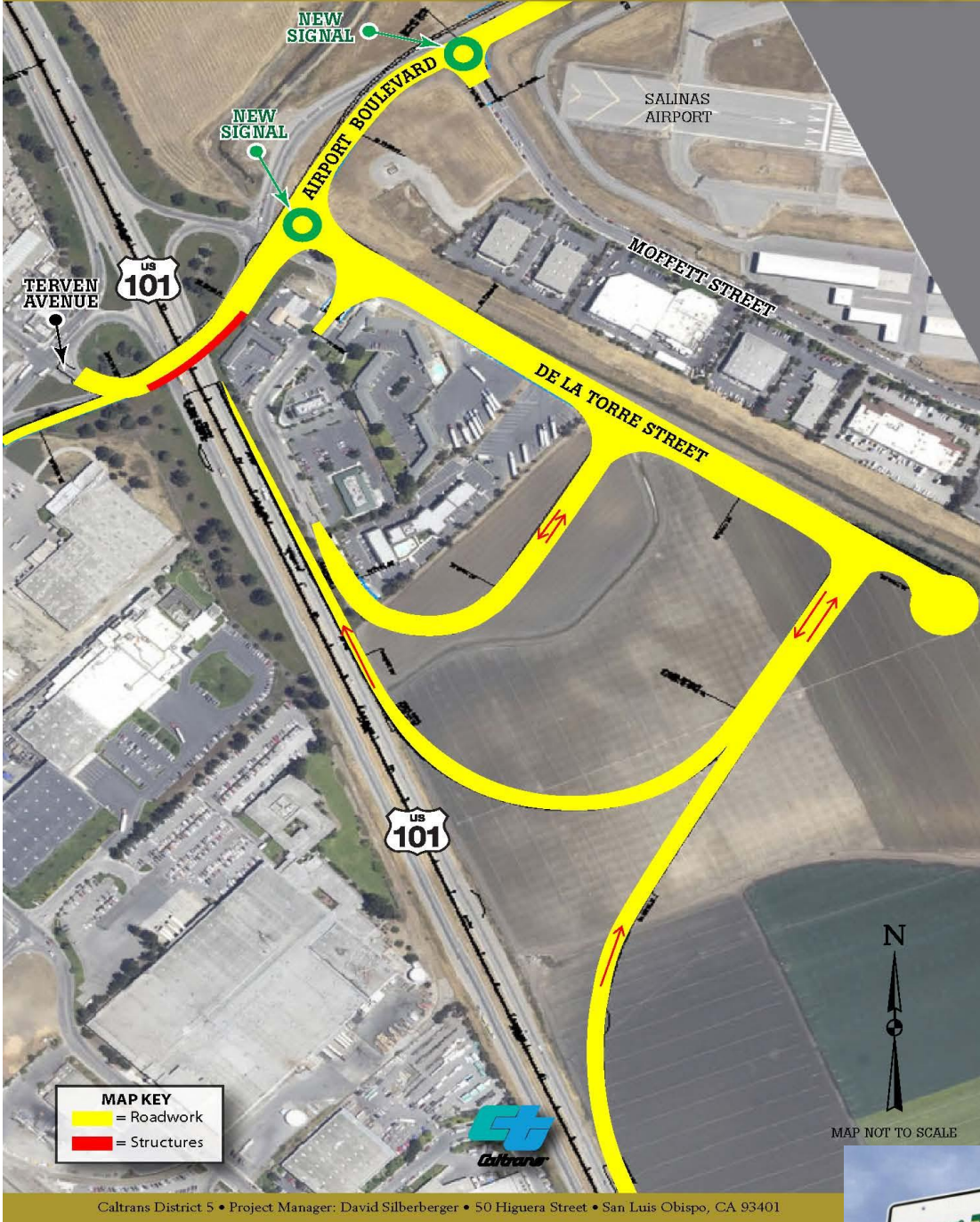
