## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

 The project will widen Highway 156 from 2 to 4 lanes between Castroville and US 101. The project will also include construction of new interchanges at key locations and will improve access to the Oak Hills community. The interchange at US 101 and SR 156 will be modified to improve local circulation and ease the transition between SR 156 and US 101.

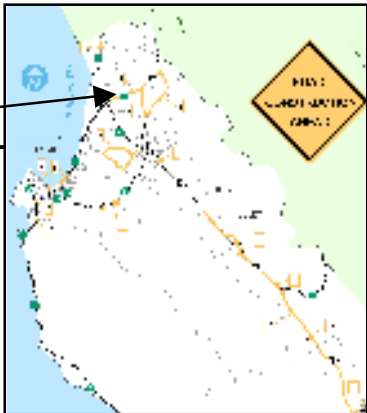
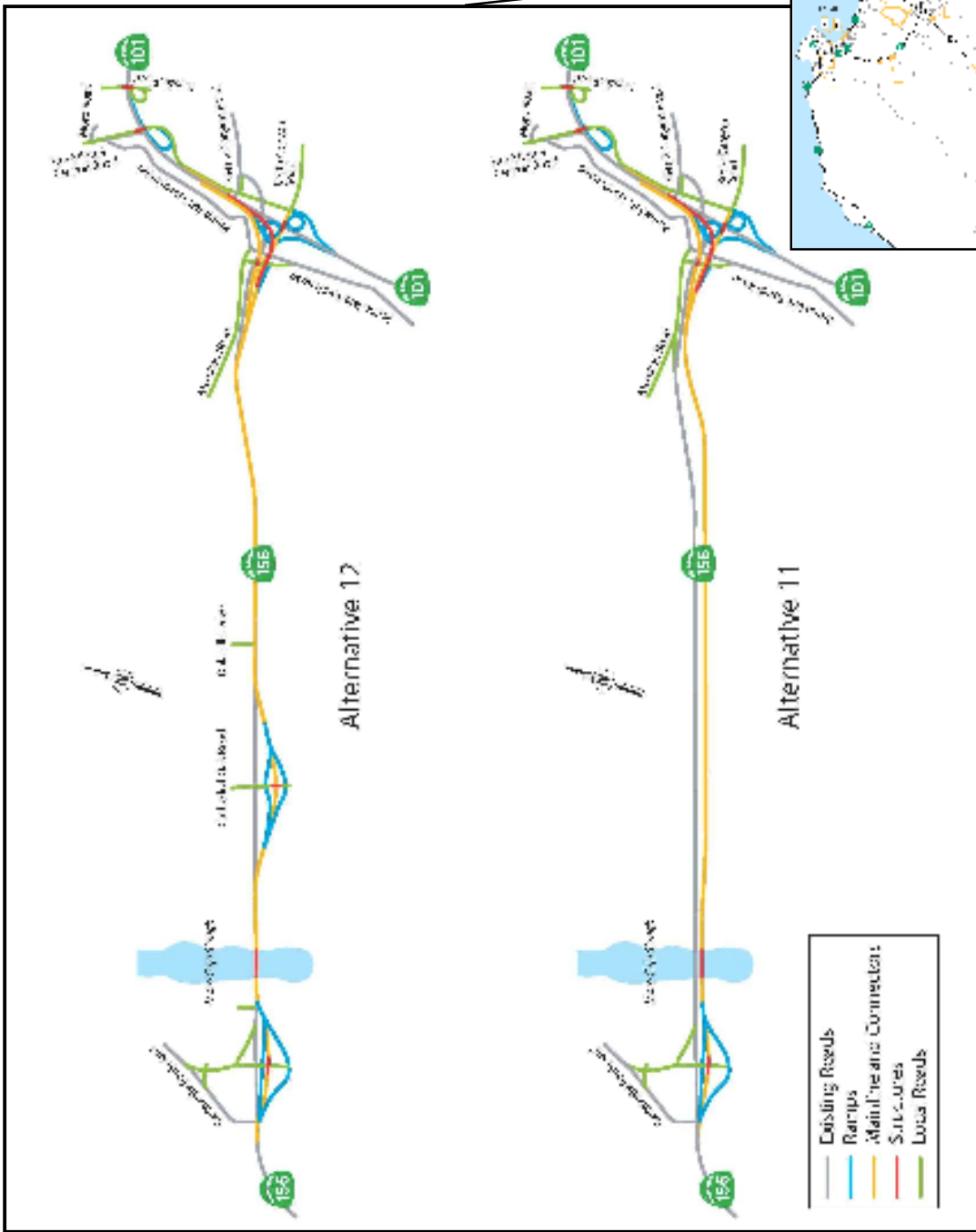
