

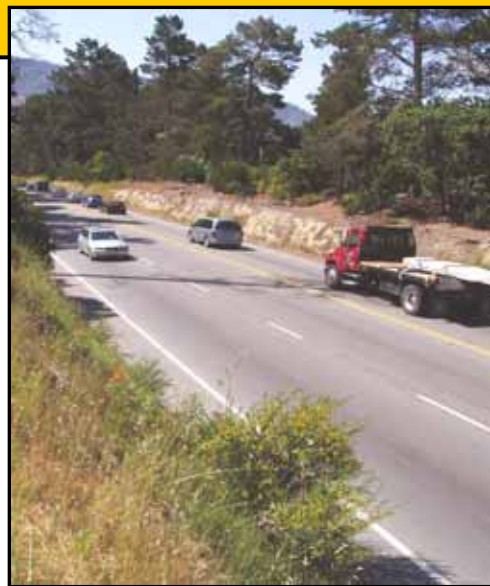
MONTEREY PENINSULA PROJECTS

ROUTE 1 - CARMEL AREA



In 2001, Monterey County and Caltrans completed a climbing lane on Route 1 between Carmel Valley Road to Ocean Avenue, greatly easing the overcrowded roadway. This new project will extend that truck climbing lane between Carmel Valley Road to Rio Road. The project will also improve the intersections at Rio Road and Carmel Valley Road to allow for improved access.

▶ Estimated cost: \$ 3,600,000

ROUTE 1 - SEASIDE/SAND CITY WIDENING



This project will widen Highway 1 from Fremont Avenue to Canyon Del Rey in Seaside. Also included are interchange and related local road improvements in the vicinity of Canyon Del Rey and Fremont Avenues, to improve access to and from Fremont Avenue, Canyon Del Rey and Highway 1.

▶ Estimated cost: \$ 65,000,000

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MONTEREY PENINSULA PROJECTS

ROUTE 68 HOLMAN HIGHWAY - CHOMP



This project will widen Route 68 (Holman Highway) from 2 to 4 lanes between the Community Hospital of Monterey Peninsula (CHOMP) and Highway 1. Also included are operational improvements to the Highway 68 – Highway 1 interchange and to Highway 68, to improve motorists' access to and from Highways 1 and 68.

▶ Estimated cost: \$23,000,000

DEL MONTE AVE - MONTEREY



This project will add an eastbound lane from El Estero to Sloat Avenue in Monterey to improve safety and vehicle access to downtown Monterey, New Monterey and Pacific Grove via Del Monte. The project includes intersection improvements at Sloat and Aguajito Avenues, such as the addition of left turn lanes and improvements to signal operations. The project will also expand the viewshed to the Window-on-the-Bay.

▶ Estimated cost: \$38,000,000
