



TAMC Grant- Alliance on Aging Annual Report of Activities for FY21-22 (July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022)

1. Conduct ten trainings with goal to train 100 individuals

Date, Organization, number of attendees:

We provided nine trainings to 72 individuals. This goal was not met due to COVID and the inability to attract a large number of people at any given event. We tried to use Zoom as a mechanism to safely reach seniors but technology proved too challenging to navigate for the general public.

2. Maintain a comprehensive list of senior transportation resources

This task has been completed and we periodically update it as necessary.

3. Attend 40 Community Events/Sites to Distribute 1350 Flyers/Marketing Materials to 1500 Seniors/Family Members (20 events/sites in North County & South County)

We participated in 166 events and reached 4515 people.

Some of the largest outreach events include: Monterey County Seniors and Veterans Fair, 'Vision 2040 Sherwood Park Resource Fair', 'Ciclovia Salinas', Dole Safety Resource Fair.

We distributed 6015 flyers.

Transportation staff were on-site weekly (9am – 1pm) at Taylor Farms Wellness Clinic in Gonzales.

We posted transportation announcements on Alliance on Aging website. Transportation Program was featured in our monthly newsletter and/or a special announcement is sent electronically to over 3100 subscribers. A total of 63,377 newsletters/announcements were distributed.

4. Distribute 900 bus passes to at least 250 Seniors

We responded to 331 requests for passes and as a result distributed 1310 bus passes to seniors.

5. Provide individual assessment by appointment or One-on-One travel training to 200 Seniors

We provided consultation to 270 individuals (29% self- identified as 'disabled').

6. Refer 200 Seniors/Family Members to transportation and Assist with Registration

Number of referrals: 351

Number assisted with registration: 128 clients were assisted with Taxi Voucher renewals and we enrolled 68 new clients into the program.

7. Coordinate 6 workshops with City Officials, Transportation Providers, Community Members and other Stakeholders in North County and South County Communities
