

## TAMC Board 25 Feb 2026 SB1 grants process

Dear Board Members .

During many of the discussions surrounding SR68, there has been continual reference to SB1 funding and grant cycles., relating to the need to spend monies on certain areas of design etc in order to to make decisions to meet submission deadlines.

I do understand that SB1 Grant applications are not particularly straight forward and there are several actual Grant programs that can be leveraged for combining funds for individual projects.

We seem to constantly hear comments like “ we must get this part of the design done, so we can meet the Grant application deadlines”

The case in hand of course is the Phase 1 SR68 Corridor Improvement, for which we are entering into the first part of the AI ATSC Pilot Program phase

Discussions will no doubt be had, regarding the length of the initial timeline to determine the flow baselines , which will be used to make construction decisions and I am sure that the “:grant application deadline card” will more than likely be played.

So my questions are realtime to SR68 Phase 1 .:

1. Can someone please concisely explain which grants will be considered and applied for,?
2. What are the specific processes and detailed timelines/deadlines for the relevant grant submissions to be made ?
3. What in reality would be the result of a grant application deadline not being met..e.g when is the next start of grant cycle eg 12 months time?
4. If SB1 grant funds are provided...but the project gets delayed or indeed does not happen..can those grant funds be used for other projects in the County?

I look forward to hearing concise answers to these questions during item 10..Draft Overall Work Program, Budget and Integrated Funding session at the TAMC Board Meeting 25 February 2025.
