The Transportation Agency for Monterey County (TAMC) is requesting proposals from qualified and interested consultants or consultant teams to perform land surveying, engineering design, right-of-way, utility relocation, community and stakeholder outreach, bidding support, and grant application support for the California Avenue segment of the Fort Ord Regional Trail and Greenway (FORTAG).

The following are TAMC's responses to questions on the RFP:

1. Is hazardous material testing to be included in the scope of work or conducted by the Agency under a separate contract?

Hazardous material testing will not be included in the scope of work. Hazardous material testing beyond what was conducted in the Environmental Impact Report section 4.9 is not required at this time. 2. Please confirm involvement of UC Santa Cruz. Project alignment seems to be outside of the UC Santa Cruz Fort Ord Natural Reserve area boundary.

The UC Regents will not be involved in the FORTAG California Ave Segment project. The alignment of the FORTAG California Ave Segment is entirely within City of Marina property.
