The Transportation Agency for Monterey County (TAMC) is seeking request for proposals from qualified consultant or consultant team to perform land surveying, engineering design, right-of-way, utility relocation, community and stakeholder outreach, and bidding support for Phase 1 of the Canton Del Rey.SR 218 segment of the Fort Ord Regional Trail and Greenway (FORTAG).

The following are TAMC’s responses to questions on the RFP:

1. Does this scope of work include implementing the mitigation measures from the EIR or does TAMC anticipate those would be included in the construction bid/contract at a later date?

A: While TAMC does not expect environmental to have a huge role in this RFP, TAMC will need planning support during PS&E for the following tasks:

- a. **Preparing supporting documentation for permits (i.e. CDFW, Army Corp, etc.)**
 - b. **Locating ESA fencing on the plans.**
 - c. **Adding mitigation provisions in the specs for EIR compliance.**
 - d. **Enviro checklist for the construction manager and contractor.**
2. Can you please clarify the Professional Liability Insurance requirements for this project? The typed dollar amounts do not match the numeric values in the sample Standard Agreement included with the RFP. See Snippet for reference:

9. Insurance.

- (a) Without limiting Consultant's duty to indemnify as set forth in this Agreement, Consultant shall maintain, at no additional cost to TAMC, throughout the term of this Agreement a policy or policies of insurance with the following coverage and minimum limits of liability:
- ✓ Commercial general liability insurance, including but not limited to premises, personal injury, products, and completed operations, with a combined single limit of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence.
 - ✓ Professional liability insurance in the amount of not less than One Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) per claim and Three Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) in the aggregate, to cover liability for malpractice or errors or omissions made in the course of rendering professional services. If professional liability insurance is written on a "claims made" basis rather than an "occurrence" basis, Consultant shall, upon the expiration or termination of this Agreement, obtain extended reporting coverage ("tail coverage") with the same liability limits. Any such tail coverage shall continue for at least three years following the surviving term of Consultant's obligation to defend, indemnify and hold harmless TAMC as set for in Paragraph 8.

A: The Professional liability insurance requirements are Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) per claim and Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) in the aggregate.
