- Expedite disbursement of available funds by funding projects that are “shovel-ready”

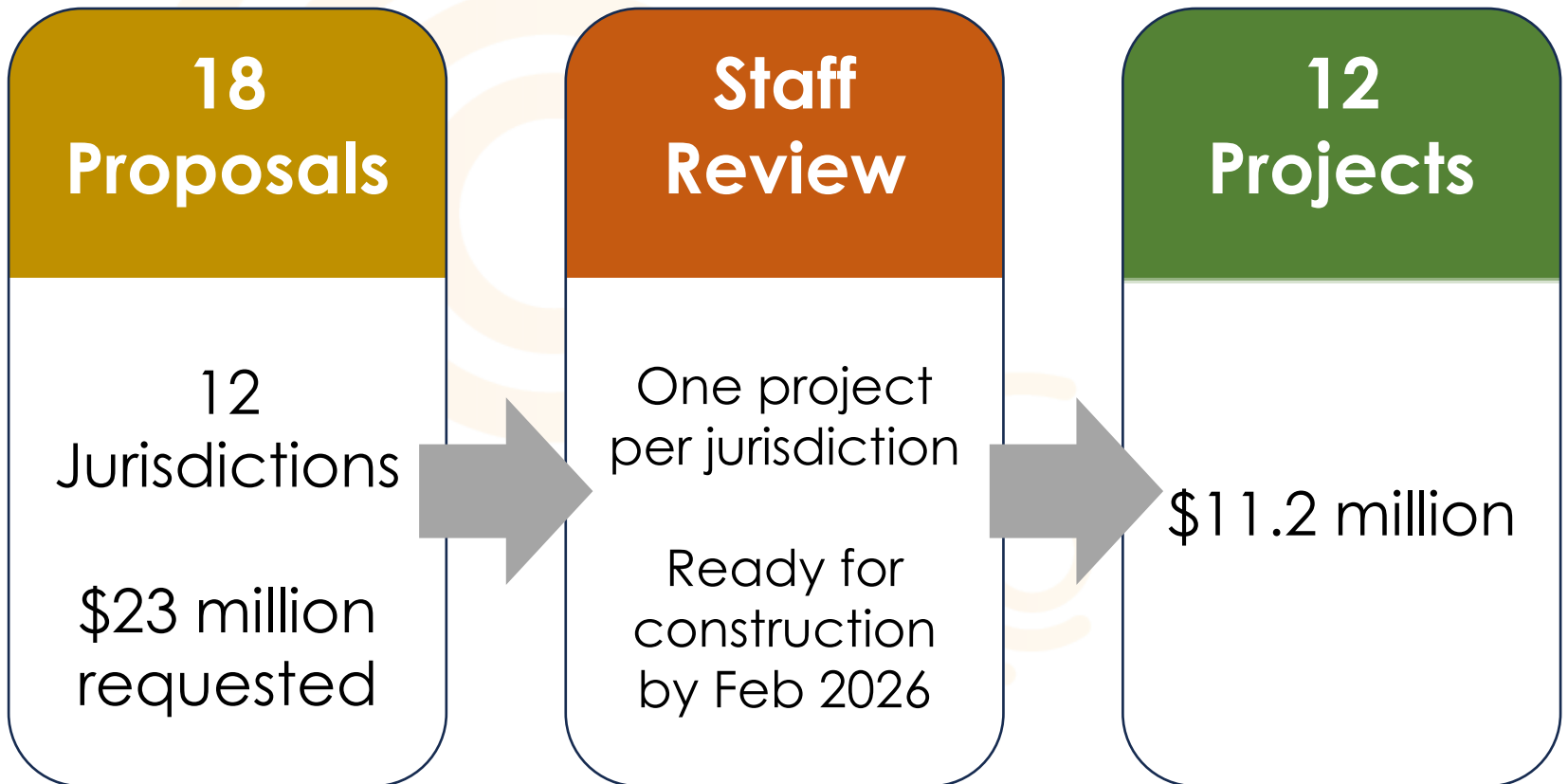
Project Eligibility

- More than 50% complete with design plans
- Begin construction before July 2026

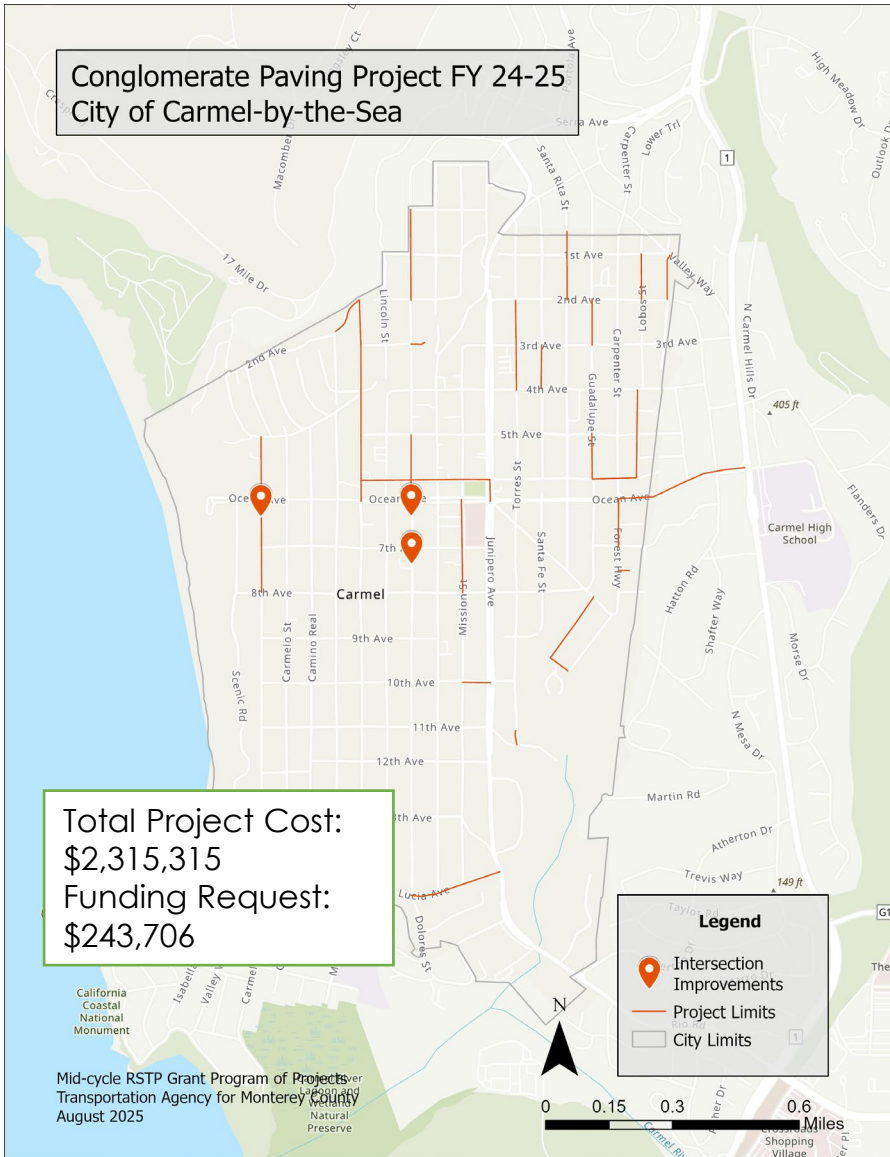
Funding

Imjin Parkway & 3rd Avenue Signal Improvements Project City of Marina

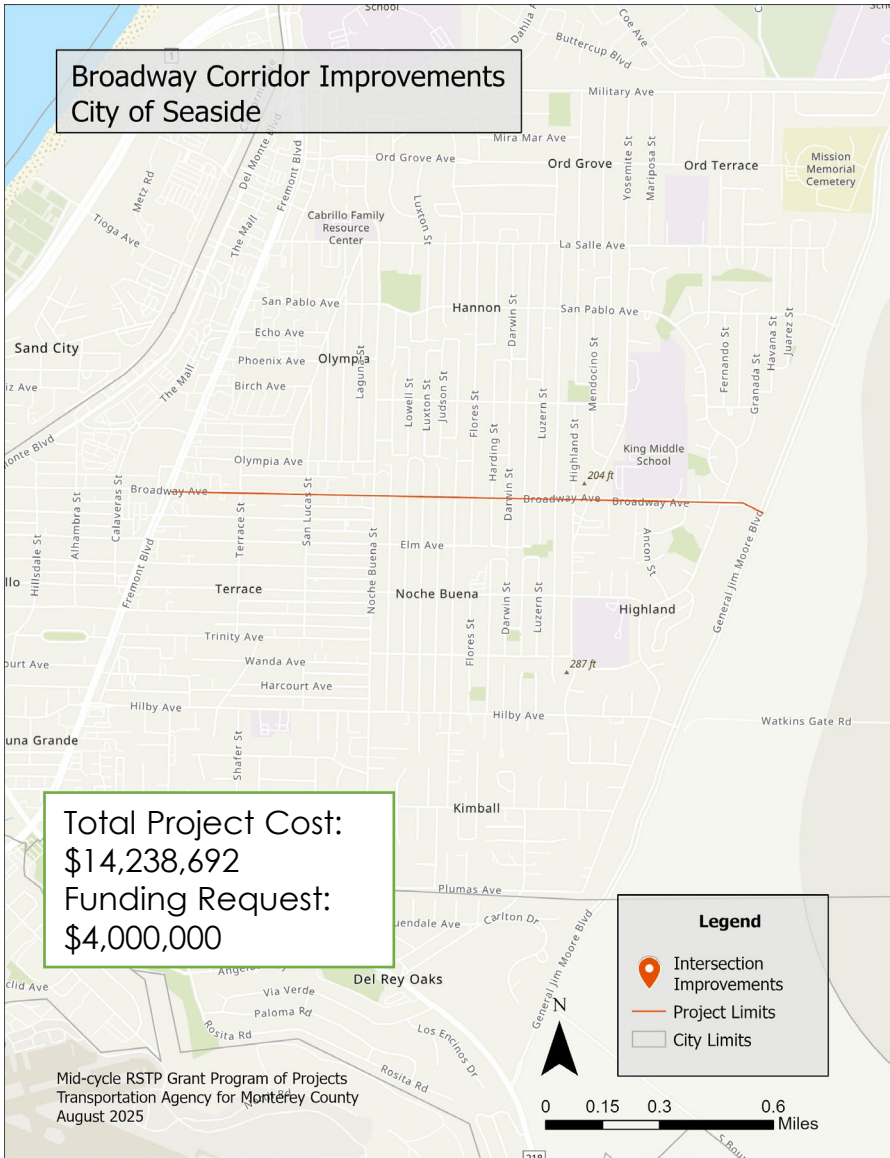

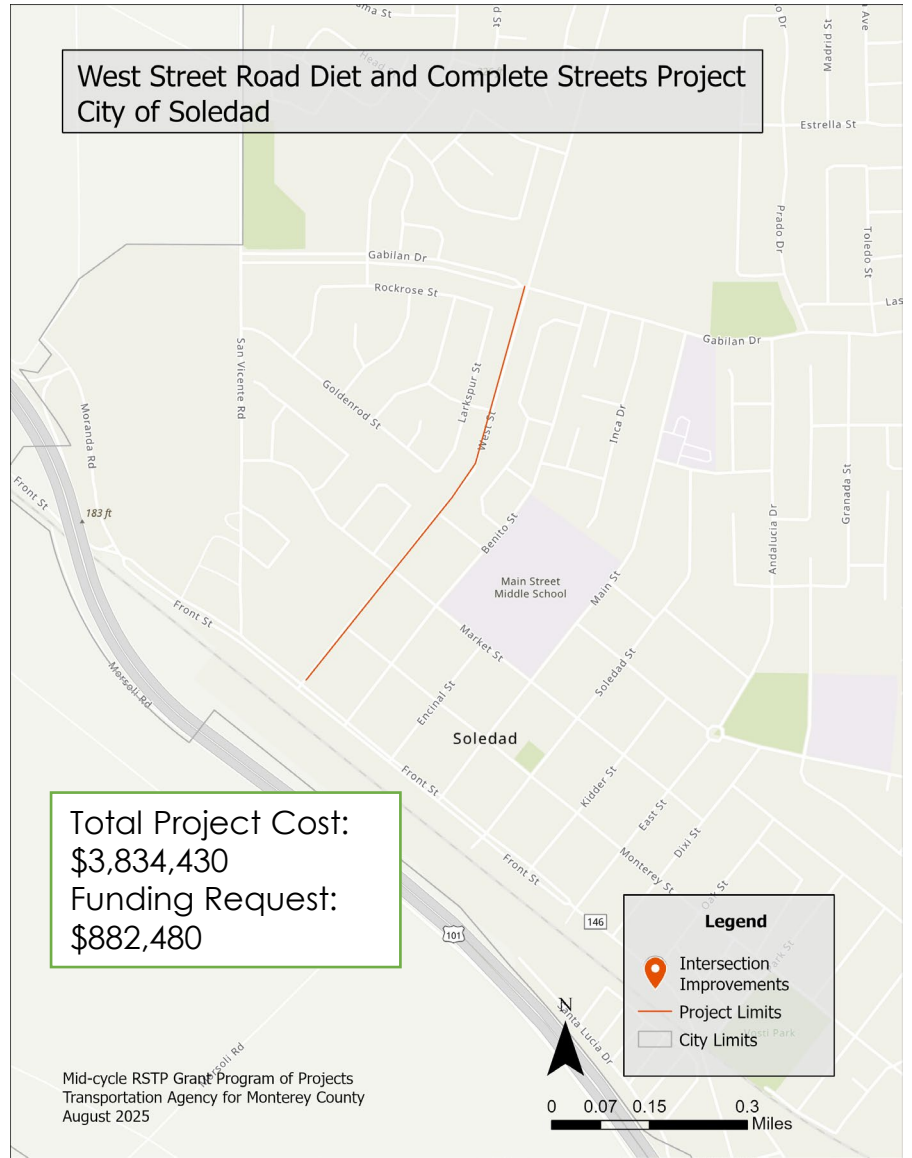




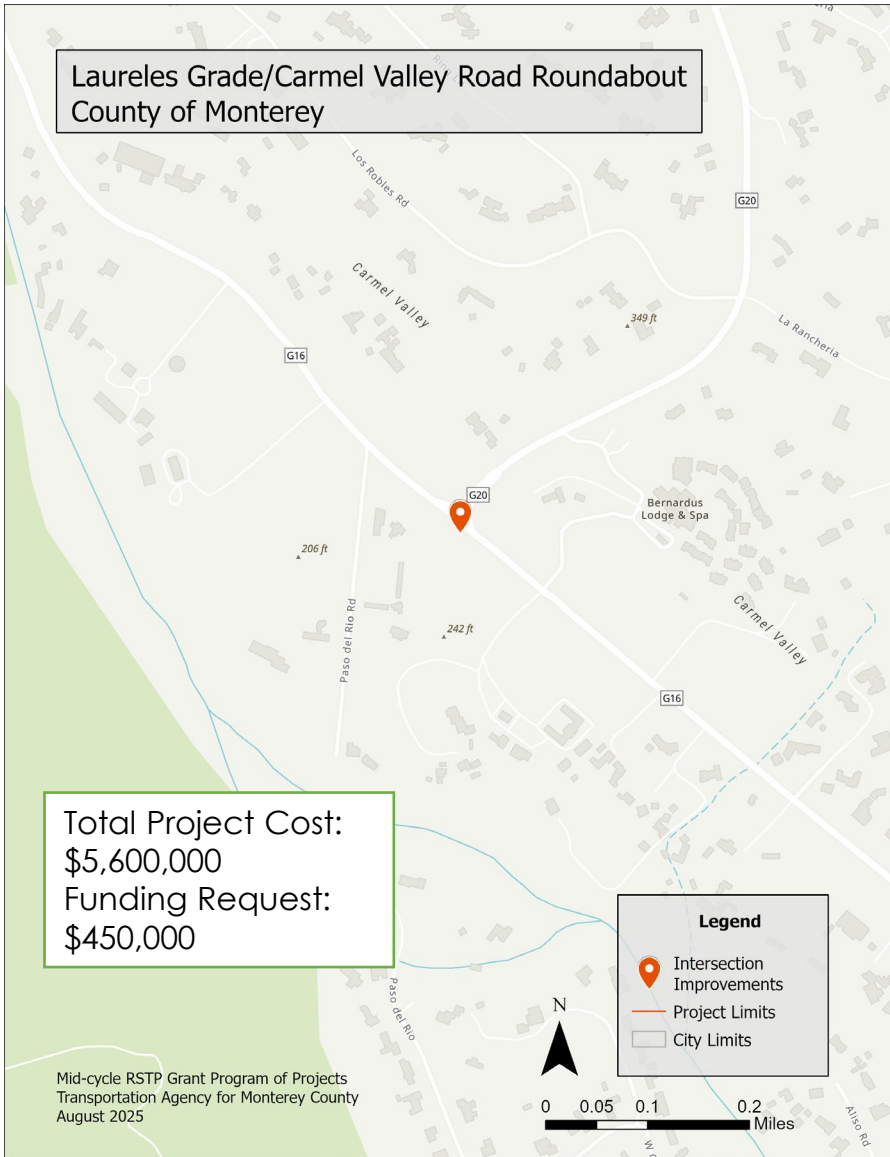
