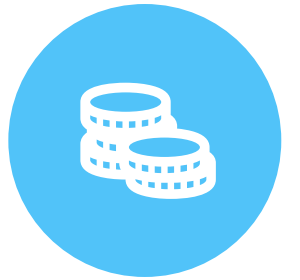

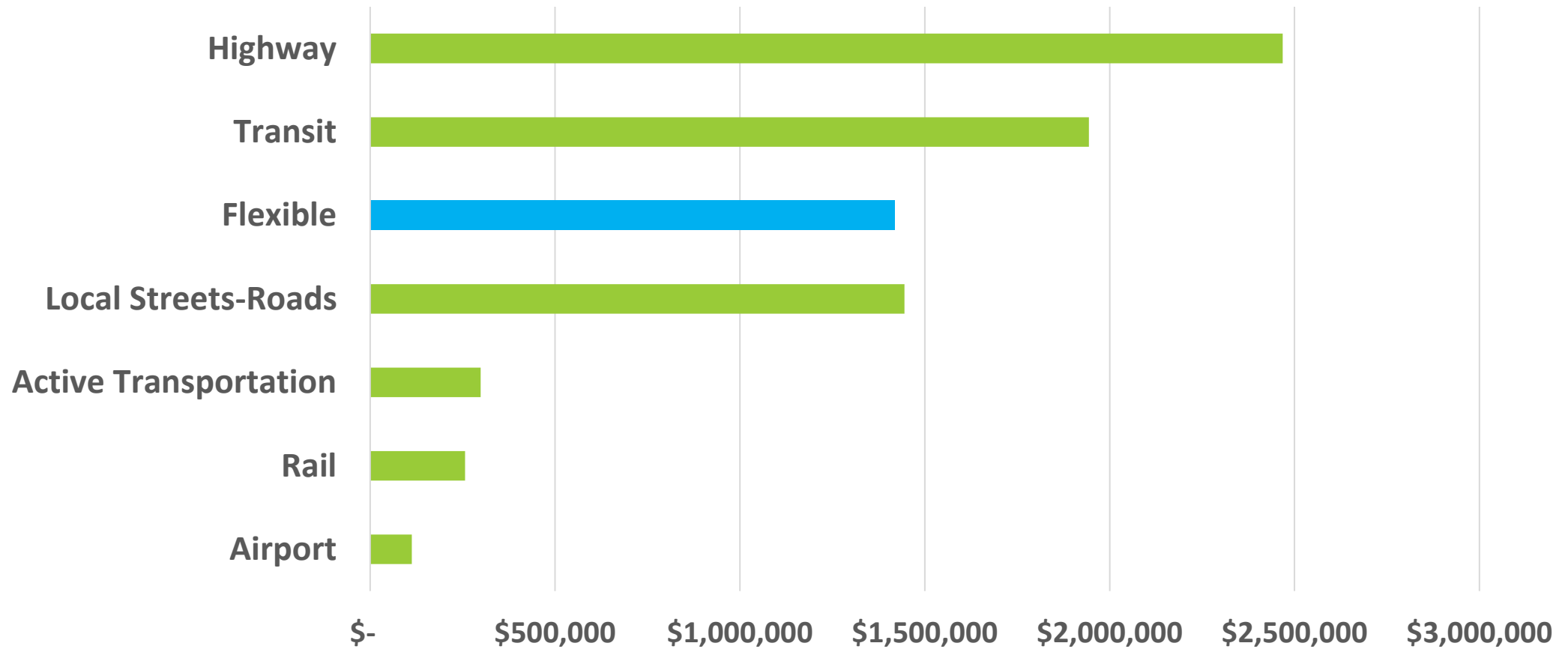

### Unconstrained

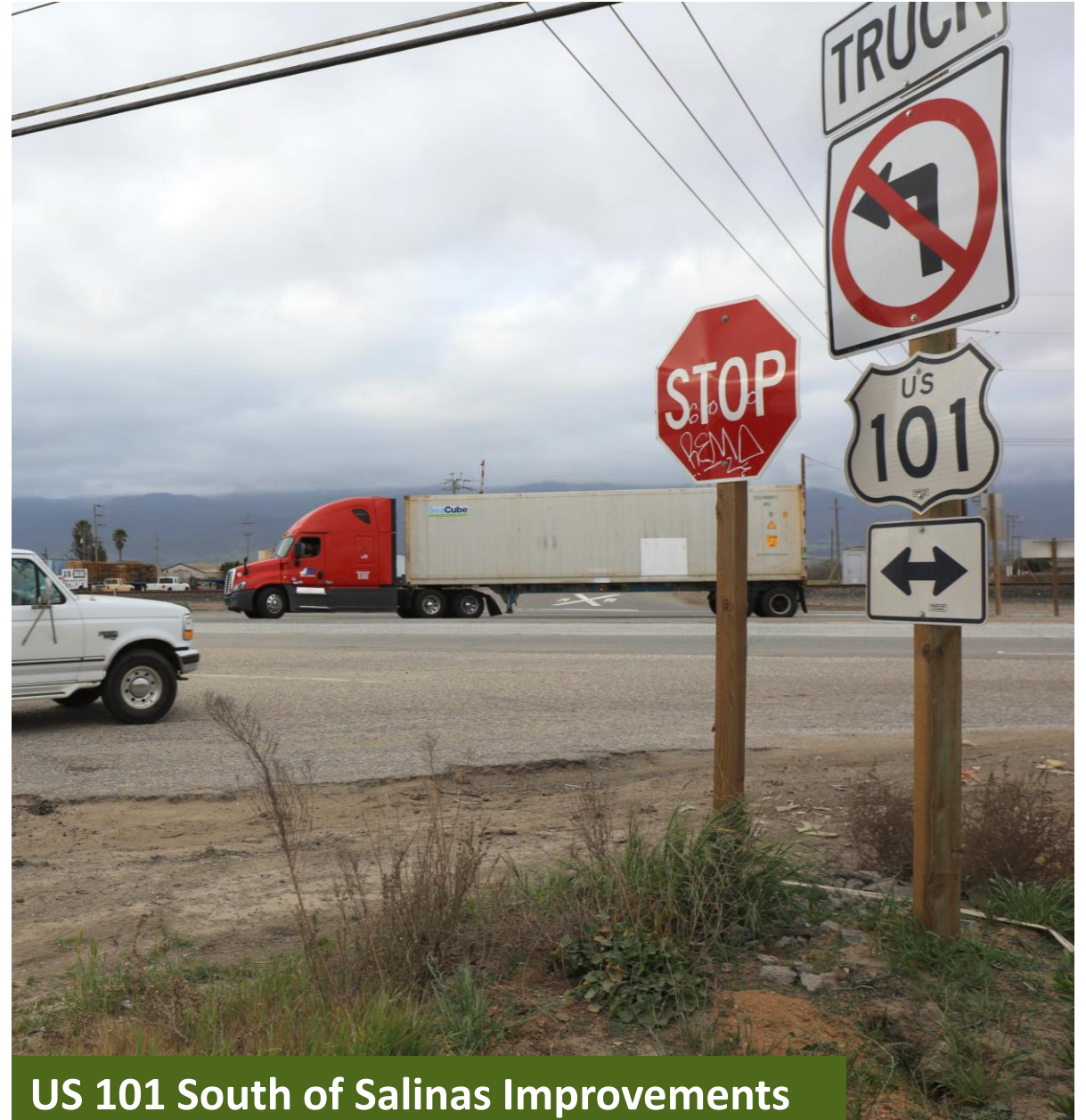
- No programmed or committed funds

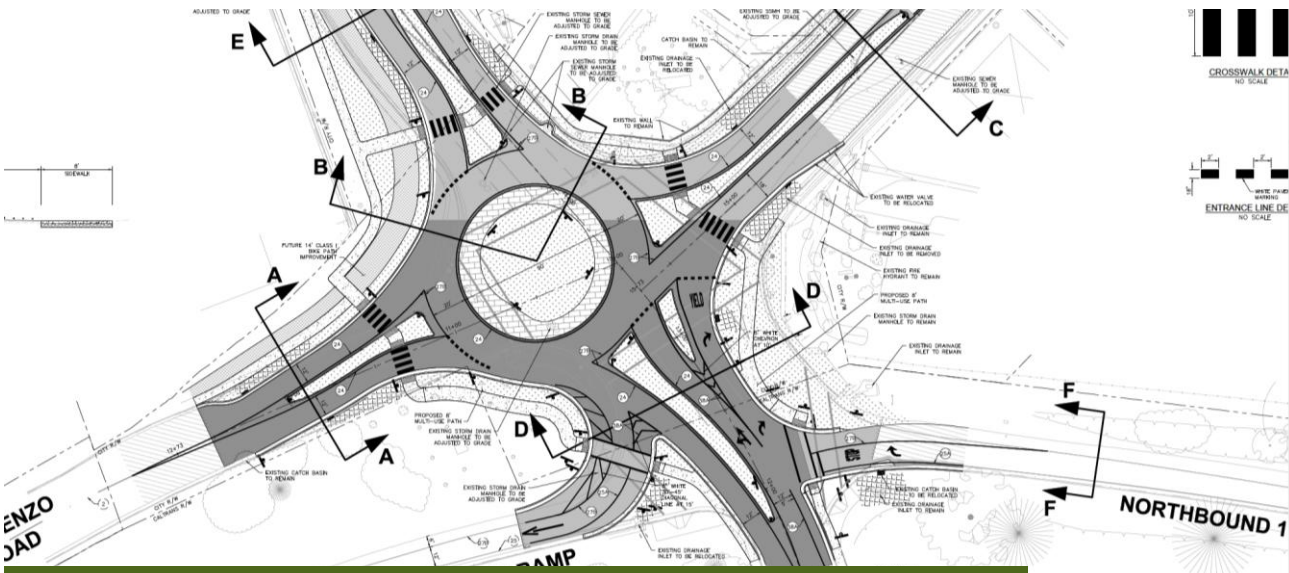


US 101 South of Salinas Improvements

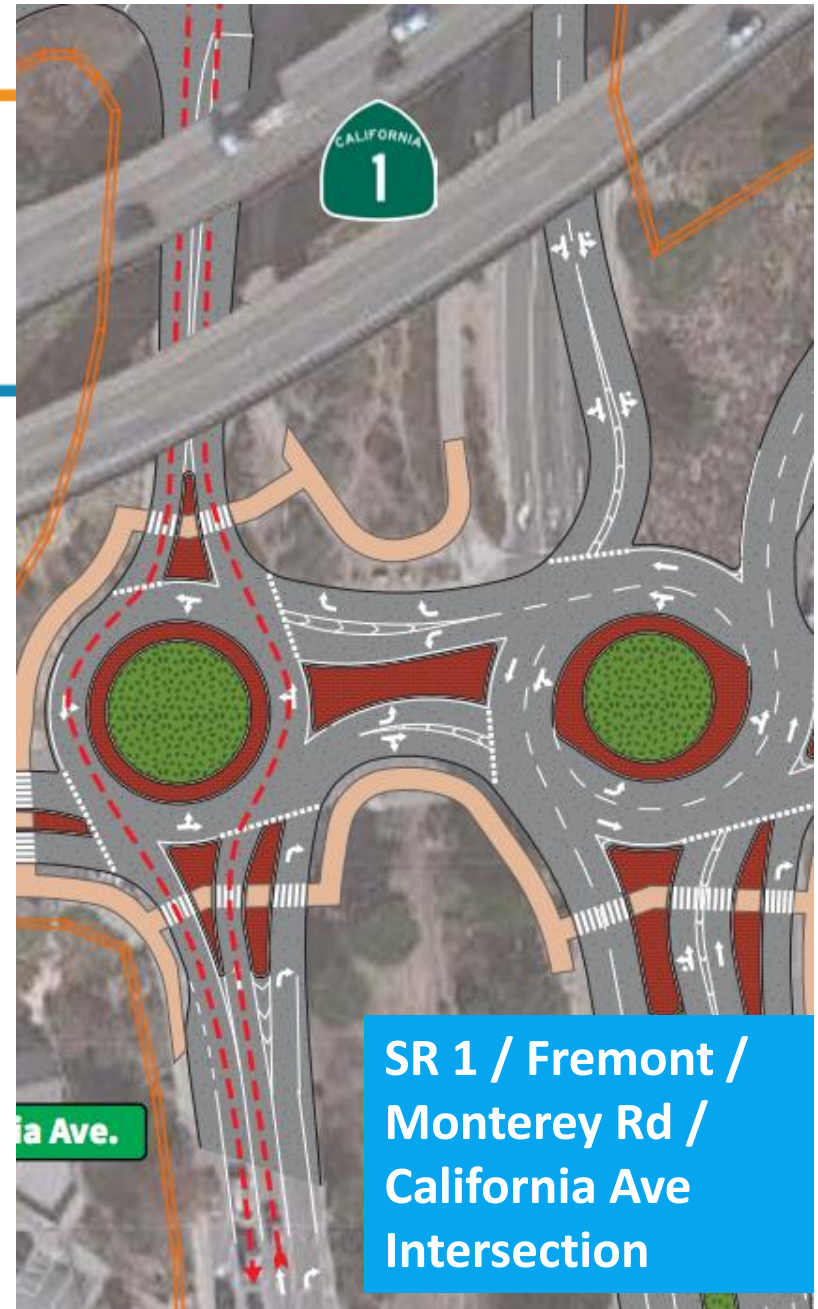
