Pavement Rehabilitation

- Measure X funded design and construction combined with SB 1 and General Fund
- Residential roadway segments were overlaid with HMA. The scope of the work included base repairs, AC overlay, and accessibility improvements
- Project Completed – May 2025

Hilby Avenue Traffic Calming

- Measure X funded Design and Construction combined with SB 1 and General Funds.
- Speed Cushions, Slurry Seal, Striping, and Signage
- Hilby Avenue and Sonoma Avenue from Yosemite Street to Mescal Street.
- Project Completed in December 2025



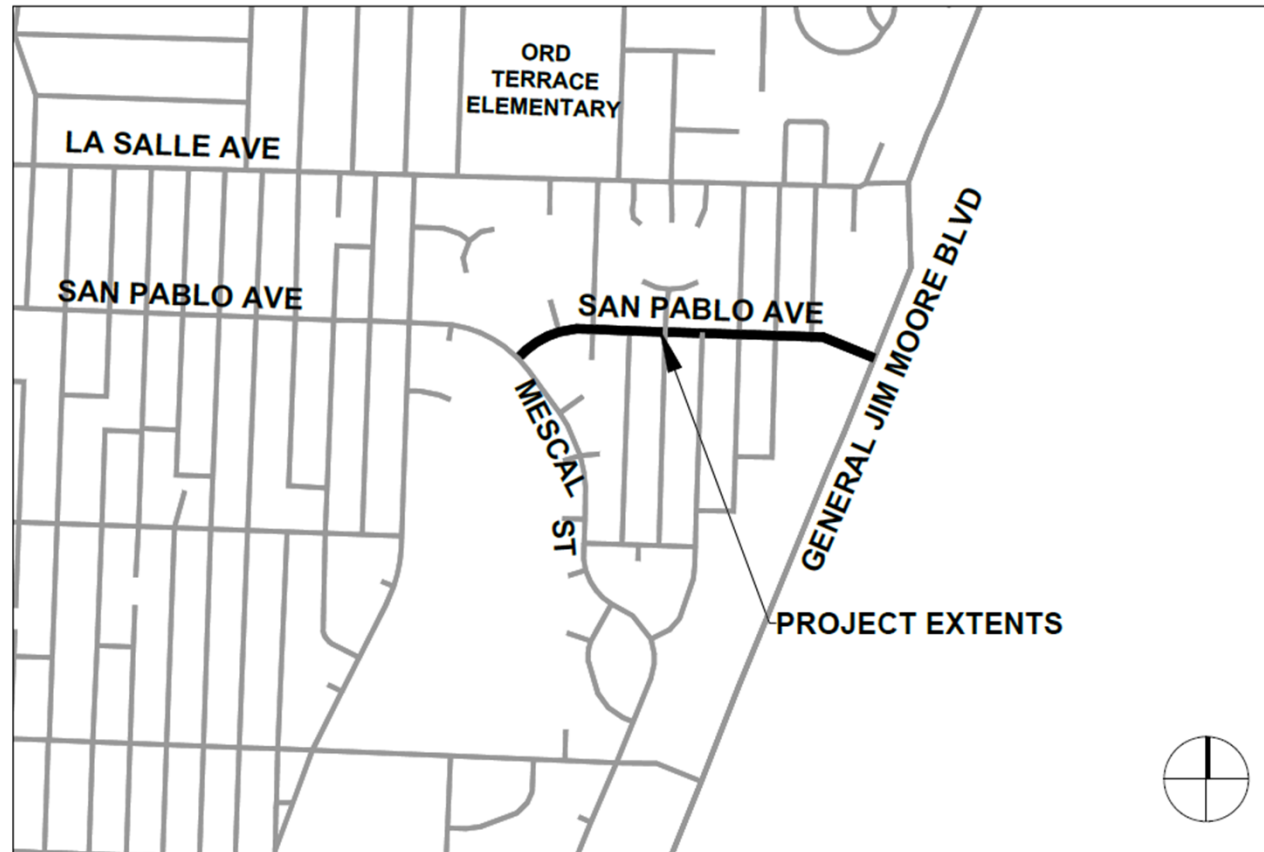
Citywide ADA Curb Ramp



- Measure X funded combined with CDBG funding
- Removal of non-compliant curb returns and replacement with accessible curb ramps per Caltrans A88A standard detail at 44
- Completed in June 2025 and Summer 2026

San Pablo Avenue Traffic Calming

- Measure X funded Design with Construction funded with SB 1 funds.
- Speed Cushions, Slurry Seal, Striping, and Signage
- San Pablo Avenue from Mescal Street to General Jim Boulevard.
- Project Completed in February 2026

Citywide Street Sign Upgrades

- Measure X funded Installation in FY 25/26
- Installation of a flashing stop signs at Broadway/Calaveras and at Broadway/Hillsdale, a street name sign replacements at Del Monte Boulevard and Tioga Avenue, and at Fremont Blvd. and Ord Grove.



Additional Projects

- Terrace Street Paving (April 2025)
- Fremont/Monterey Gap Closure (August 2025)
- Coe Avenue Traffic Calming (March 2025)
- Broadway Avenue Complete Streets Corridor Improvements Project (In Construction)
- Pavement Management Program (On-Going)
- Auto Center Parkway Improvements (October 2025)
