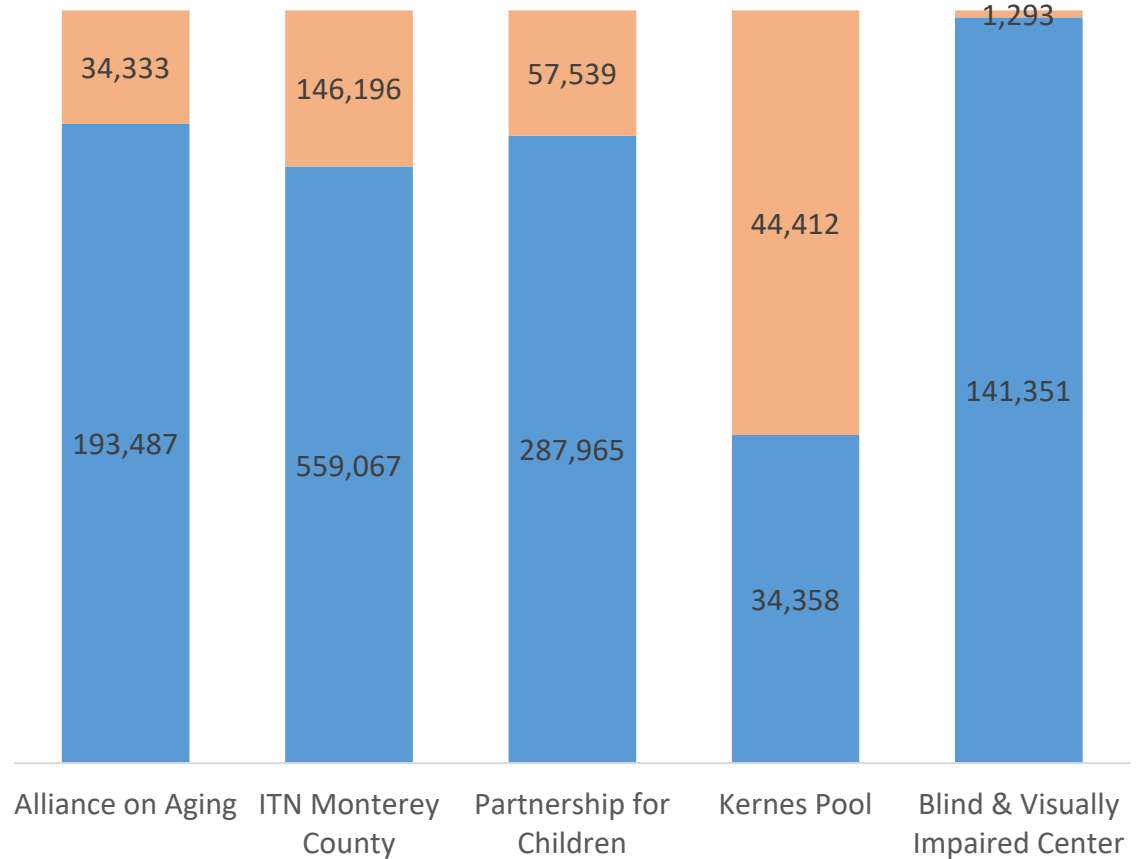
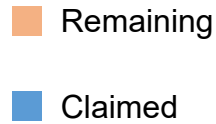




Cycle 3
