4 CITY OF SALINAS – INCORPORATING IMPROVEMENTS IN PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE

The Committee received a presentation from the City of Salinas on how they integrate complete streets and other improvements into their regular pavement maintenance projects.

Gerardo Rodriguez and Adriana Robles, City of Salinas Public Works Department presented on the City of Salinas, Pavement Management and Street Selection Policy. Ms. Robles works for the city's Engineering Division and manages the paving program. She noted that once streets are ready for repaving, they coordinate with the Traffic Division to see if there are desired changes to the existing stripping to implement complete street concepts. She noted that the Traffic Division checks various city planning documents, including the Active Transportation Plan, Vision Zero Plan, and Safe Routes to Schools Plan, to see if there are recommendations that can be incorporated.

The paving budget is limited, and changes are generally limited to stripping and sometimes bollards or delineators. There are some standard changes that are implemented on all streets, such as upgrading crosswalks to a high-visibility design.

5. REGIONAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM GUIDELINES UPDATE SUBCOMMITTEE

The committee received an update on the Regional Surface Transportation Program and recommended up to three committee members to join a Guidelines Update Subcommittee.

Janneke Strause, Associate Transportation Planner reported that the Regional Surface Transportation Program funds are distributed to eligible agencies on a three-year cycle through the Transportation Agency's Competitive Grant Program. She noted that the next cycle of the Competitive Grant Program is in 2026 and the 2026 RSTP Guidelines will be brought to the TAMC Board for approval in March. Ms. Strause noted that the Transportation Agency staff requested two to three members of the Technical Advisory Committee join an RSTP Guidelines Update Subcommittee to provide feedback on updates to the guidelines.
